



Utah Tech University Medical Radiography Program Expenses

The student can expect to incur the following expenses for the Medical Radiography Program.
These costs are only an estimate and are subject to change.

Students should be aware that the tuition charged is based on the base price of either resident or non-resident UT tuition plus a \$60.00 per credit tuition differential. Differential tuition is an additional tuition charged per credit hour over and above the university tuition. These funds are returned directly to the program to cover student supplies, professional organization memberships and maintenance of equipment and take the place of course fees.
