



Clinical Obligations

Medical Radiography students are assigned clinical hours as a critical element of their education and training to become a qualified Radiologic Technologist. The Dixie State University Radiography Program is affiliated with acute care hospitals, orthopedic clinics, outpatient imaging centers, and specialty clinics for student training sites. The Clinical Coordinator will assign students to a variety of training sites throughout the program giving each student a comprehensive clinical experience. Clinical placement is nondiscriminatory and solely determined by program faculty.

Professional liability insurance is provided by the university for program students while performing required clinical assignments.

Transportation to and from the clinical site is the student's responsibility.
